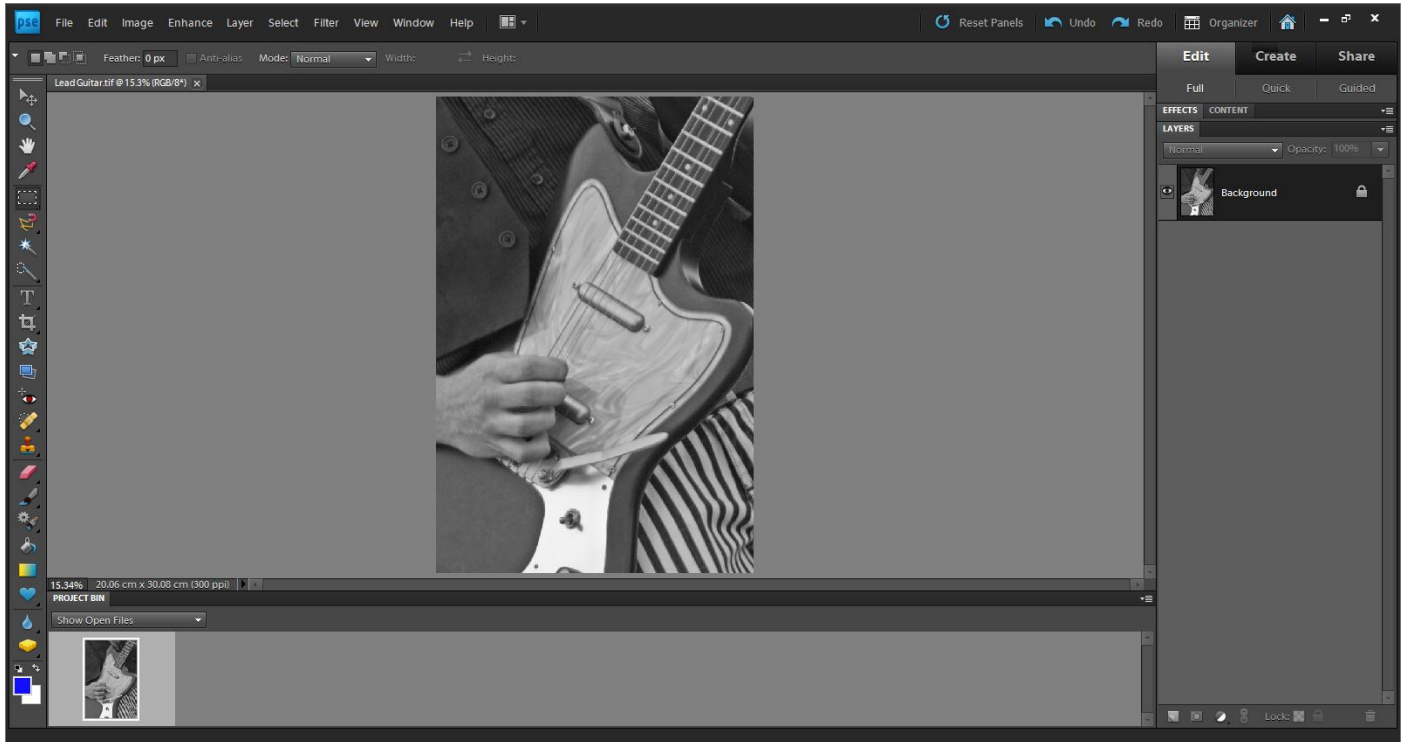
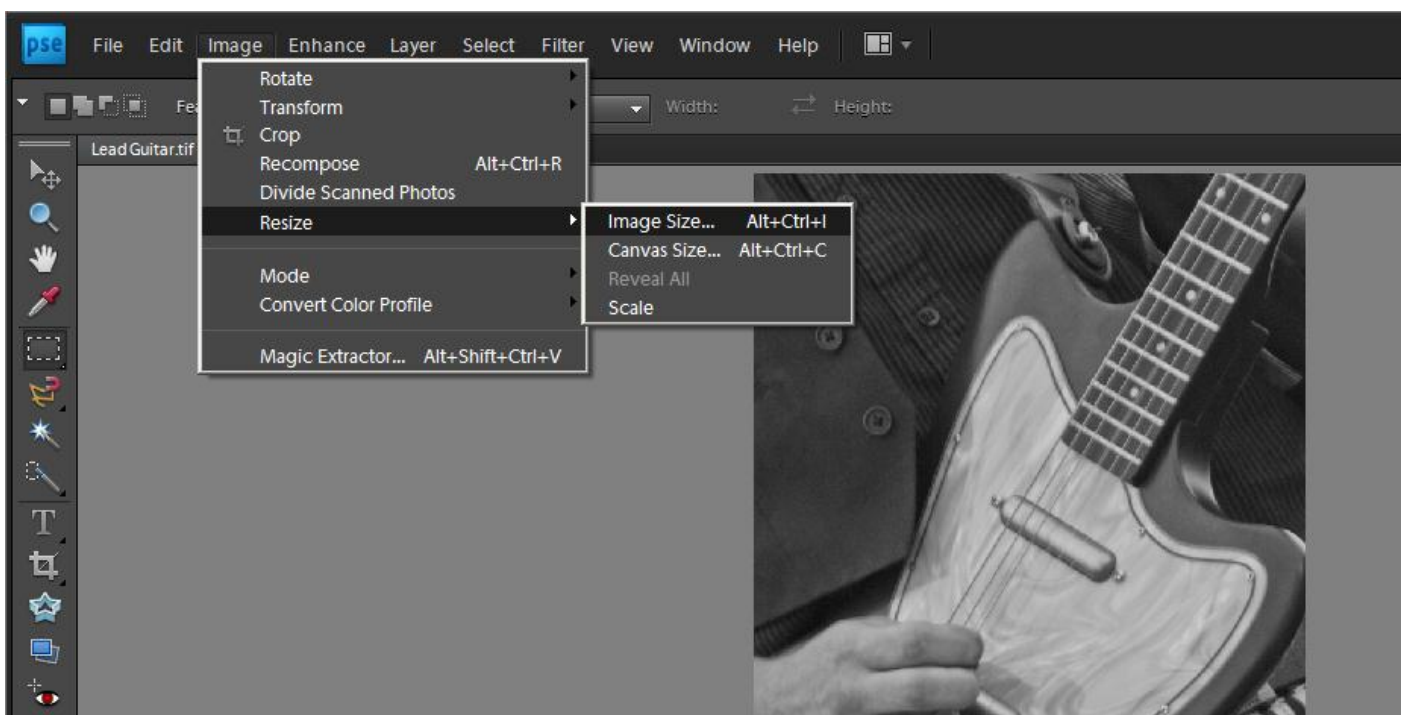


Resizing Your Images for SSDCC Website Gallery Using Elements 9

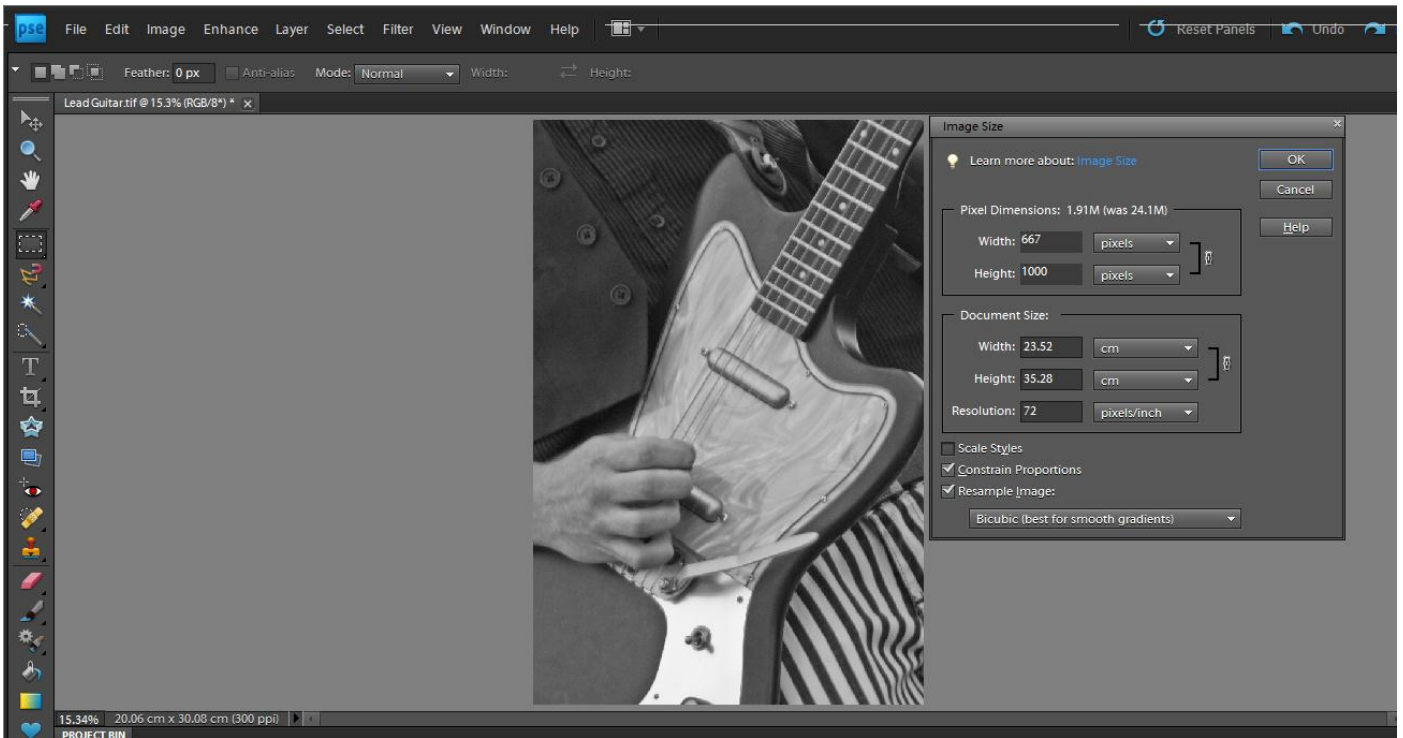
This tutorial will show you how to resize your images for use in the SSDCC Website Gallery, using Elements 9, although this method should be okay for any version of Elements. So to begin with, start up your copy of Elements and open up your image by going to File/Open and navigating to its file. I have opened up 'Lead Guitar.tif' as you can see.



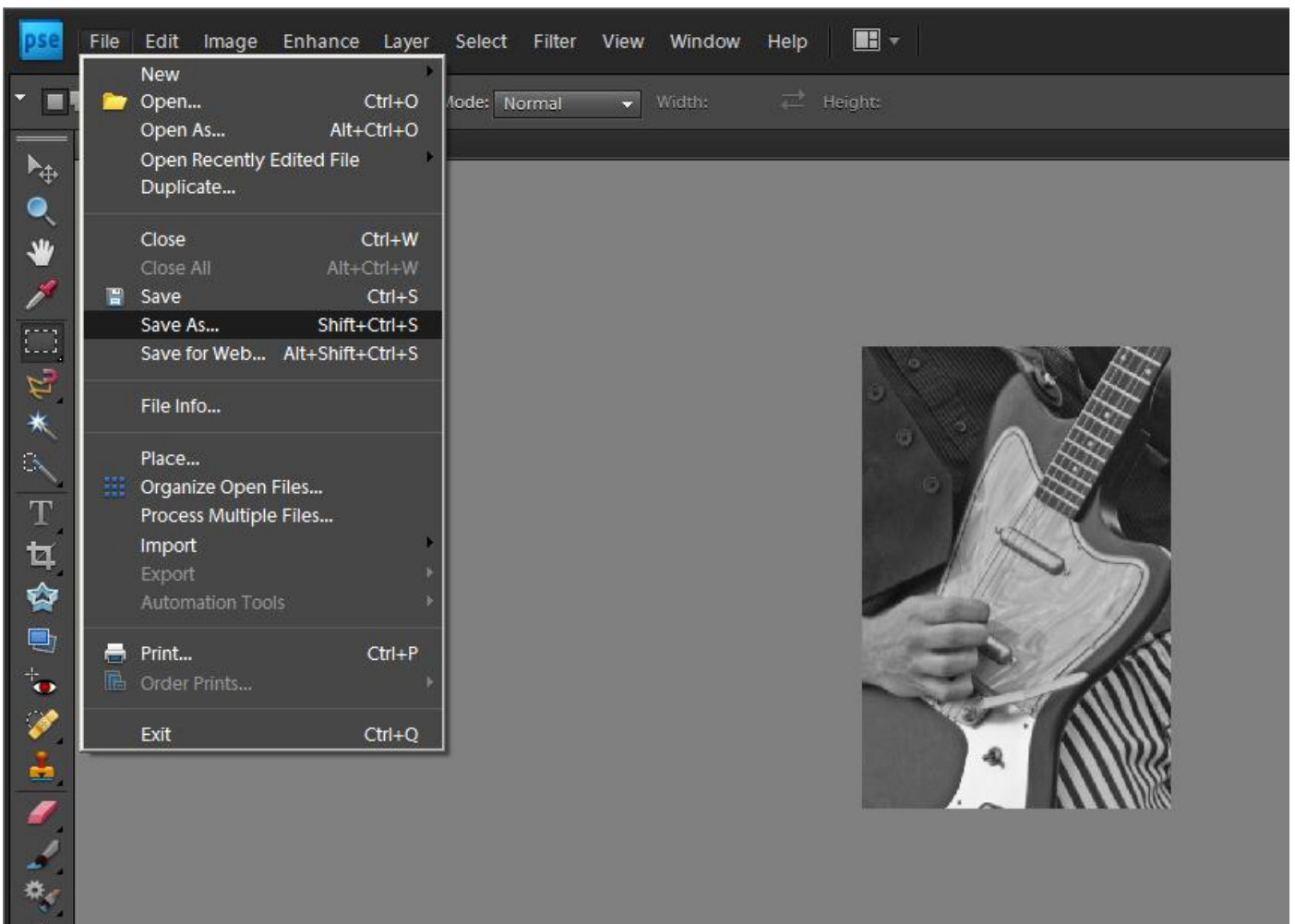
Now go to Image/Image Size or press Alt+Ctrl+I to access the Image Size dialogue.



With the Image Size dialogue pops onto your screen. Tick where it says, 'Resample Image' and change your resolution to 72 pixels per inch and change the pixel dimensions to 1000 ppi depending if your image is portrait or landscape. The other value will change automatically.



Now click OK or hit Enter or Return to resize your image. As you can see your image has been resized and all that is left to do is resave it as a .jpg file. Go to File/Save As and save the image as you wish. The website does not mind what your file name is.



Choose 12 (maximum) in the JPEG Options and click OK. Congratulations! You can now correctly resize and rename your images for the website gallery using Elements. Regards, Paul
